Shopping course to enjoy the Shinko area

This course includes a restaurant where you can enjoy the sea breeze, a hands-on experience of making your own original cup noodles, and shopping.

Hint

Most facilities are equipped with accessible restrooms, and the roads are wide enough for you to enjoy yourself without stress.



It can also be reached directly from Yokohama Station by SEA BASS or Bayside Blue (bus).

The elevator here takes you to the second floor where you can go to Hammerhead via the pedestrian bridge.

In spring, the road is lined with cherry blossoms. We recommend Queen's Square if it rains.

YOKOHAMA HAMMERHEAD

Required time **60 minutes**

A cruise ship terminal is at the heart of this complex, which was opened in October 2019, and it also features a luxury hotel and commercial facilities. The complex houses 25 carefully selected tenants, including new businesses and stores that opened for the first time in Japan.

🚶 Elevator access to the park is available. The complex was designed for the enjoyment of all age groups, from children to the elderly, with a nursing room for feeding babies and changing diapers, and a multifunctional restroom.

Required time **30 minutes**

MARINE & WALK YOKOHAMA, located next to the YOKOHAMA RED BRICK WAREHOUSE, opened in 2016 as a new symbol of the Yokohama Minatomirai and Shinko areas. This open mall features unique stores selling select items and imported brands, as well as restaurants and cafes boasting terrace seating that takes advantage of the bayfront scenery.

Cup Noodles Museum YOKOHAMA (Momofuku Ando Invention Memorial Hall)

Required time **60 minutes**

This is a hands-on food education museum where visitors can enjoy learning about the importance of invention and discovery through a variety of exhibits and experiences related to instant ramen.

YOKOHAMA WORLD PORTERS

Required time **90 minutes**

In July 2024, a dining zone with a total of 620 seats, the largest in Minato Mirai, opened! A shopping mall with about 150 stores where you can enjoy not only shopping but also fun activities all day long. From the rooftop, you can see the entire Minato Mirai area, and the adjacent Yokohama Cosmo World ferris wheel is impressive to see up close. Furthermore, visitors can enjoy dining while admiring the night view from certain restaurants on the 5th floor.

Shinko Circle Walk

JICA Yokohama Japanese Overseas Migration Museum

Required time **45 minutes**

The museum opened in 2002 in Yokohama, Kanagawa Prefecture, one of the ports of departure of emigrant ships, to educate the general public about the history of Japanese emigration overseas and the roles and contributions that these emigrants played for the countries to which they emigrated and for Japan. In addition to the exhibition and interactive area, there is a restaurant with a view of the harbor where visitors can also enjoy halal food.
