

What to eat in Yokohama

As Yokohama has served as a gateway to the outside world, it is the birthplace of many Japanese dishes.

There is a diverse range of cuisines available in Yokohama.



Napolitan

Napolitan, The CAFE in the Hotel New Grand

This dish is said to have been created by the general chef of the Hotel New Grand in Yokohama. You can try the flavor of Napolitan that started in Yokohama and spread to the rest of Japan in the restaurant called, "The CAFE".



Sanmamen

This ramen dish was created by the successor to the founder of the well-established Chinese restaurant, Gyokusentei. Samma in Chinese means "raw vegetables". The noodles are covered in stir-fried vegetables, like bean sprouts and cabbage, in a thickened sauce.



Gyunabe (beef hotpot) A flavor from when Japan westernized during the Meiji period! "Gyunabe," originated in Yokohama, is a dish in which

Beer

The brewery that William Copeland started in 1870 in Yokohama was the first brewery in Japan and has continued to produce beer ever since. Now known as Kirin Beer, the company has drawn on this history. There are also many establishments in Yokohama at which you can enjoy craft beer.
